C-7A Caribou Association's 22nd Reunion Radisson Hotel (214-630-7000) Dallas, TX 75247 September 21st – 25th, 2011

Place: The Radisson Hotel, 1241 W. Mockingbird Lane, Dallas, TX 75247 (214-630-7000) will be headquarters for Reunion 2011. The hotel has 296 rooms, free highspeed internet access, free guest parking, and space for parking of RVs. URL is www.radisson.com/dallastx love.

Hotel Reservations: Group room rate is \$109.25 (includes taxes). Reservations may be made now. Specify "C-7A Caribou Association" when making your reservation. To get the group rate, your reservation must be made by 8/31/11. Hotel reservations are your responsibility and are not included in any fees paid with reunion registration. Rate good from 19-27 Sep.

Hotel Check-In: The check in time is 3:00 PM or later. Unless the hotel is full the night before, some rooms may be available a little earlier in the afternoon.

Weather: The historical averages for September are highs of 89° F., lows of 69° F., and 2.6 in. of rain.

Transportation:

By Car: The hotel is on Mocking-bird Lane at IH 35E.

By Commercial Air: The hotel provides a free shuttle bus from/to Dallas Love Field (3 miles). Love Field is served by Southwest, Continental Airlines, and Delta Airlines.

Dallas-Ft Worth Airport (DFW) is 16 miles away. Taxi and commercial shuttle bus are available at DFW.

Reunion Registration: Register

for the reunion by mailing your completed form and check(s) made out to the C-7A Caribou Association to Pat Hanavan, 12402 Winding Branch, San Antonio, TX 78230-2770. Upon arrival, pick up your name tag and registration package at the reunion table. If you do not pre-register, every effort will be made to accommodate last minute arrivals, but we cannot guarantee the availability of an event due to varying prior-notice requirements. Reunion check- in is from 1400-2100 in the War Room. For those who arrive later, find the War Room and someone will take care of you. If you arrive before noon, come on in and help us set up!

Reception: In the War Room, from 1800-2000. Our usual snacks, supplemented with a few hot items.

The **War Room** is large and will accommodate 250 people. It will be outfitted with tables to sit around and catch up with old acquaintances. It will open at 3:00 PM on 21 September and close at midnight, and then be available from 7:00 AM to midnight on Wed. through Sat. and from 7:00 AM until noon on Sunday. Exception: During periods when reunion attendees are away, e.g., tours, the War Room will be closed (locked up) unless an Association volunteer agrees to act as War Room monitor. The Caribou Association – not the hotel – will be responsible for War Room security throughout the reunion.

Bou Flights

On Friday, it's time to kick the tires and light the fires! The highlight of the reunion is the opportunity to fly once again in our favorite airplane – the Bou. The Cavanaugh Flight Museum has a flying Bou, S/ N 62-4149. We hope to have 12-15 passengers on each 40 minute sortie of the Bou from Addison Airport (16 miles from the hotel). The flight will include takeoff and landing at Addison Airport, flight in the local area, and takeoffs and landings at an auxiliary field. Permission from the FAA for our flights is pending. Think positive!

Buses will be provided by the Association to take the Bou fliers to Addison Airport starting at 0800. The museum has an interesting collection of aircraft (see information on page 3) and a small gift shop. Buses will make several trips to and from Addison Airport. All fliers will be back at the hotel by 1700.

Alternate Activity

For those not visiting the Cavanaugh Flight Museum and/or taking a Bou flight, Friday afternoon is an opportunity to visit Northpark Center Mall (12 miles from the hotel) from 1100-1600. The Mall has over 120 shops, 20+ places to eat, and a movie theater. Many consider that is a must for a visitor to Dallas. See http://www.northparkcenter.com/for information.

The number of spaces for the C-7A flights is **strictly limited** by time and the number of seats on the Caribou. Your Registration forms will be numbered in the order in which they arrive in Pat Hanavan's mail box and spaces will be assigned based on that order of arrival. First come, first served. Make a separate check and post-date it to 8/15/11. Checks will not be deposited until then.

Return to Hotel

Our chartered buses depart from the museum at 1700 to take us back to the hotel. A bus will leave the museum at 1330 for anyone who came by bus and does not want to stay for the afternoon museum visit.

Texas BBQ Dinner

What would a reunion in Texas be without a Texas BBQ dinner? Friday evening, starting at 1730, we will shuttle by bus to Pappas BBQ. Each diner will get a plate (choose 2 from: beef, pulled pork, hickory smoked ham, turkey breast, ribs), choice of 2 vegetables (spicy rice, ranch beans, macaroni and cheese, yams, lima beans, potato salad, cucumber salad, macaroni salad, coleslaw), and beverage (soda, coffee, tea). Bus back to the hotel by 2000.

Frontiers of Flight

On Thursday, embark on a memorable aviation journey – a tour of the Frontiers of Flight Museum. During your experience, you will bridge several lifetimes, starting with the pioneers who realized their earliest dreams of flying; identifying with the aviators of the 20's and 30's, known as the "Golden Age of Flight"; understanding the sacrifices of the fliers of World War II; and progressing to the jet and rocket age of today. You will see, hear, and touch some of the rare artifacts that contributed to this exciting history.

You will see more than 200 aircraft types, representing nations involved in WW II along with the uniforms of the men and women who flew them.

Buffet Dinner

Thursday evening at 1900 we will have a buffet dinner at the hotel.
