C-7A Caribou Association's 29th Reunion Marriott at the University of Dayton, Dayton, OH September 5th – 9th, 2018

Place: Marriott at the University of Dayton will be the headquarters for Reunion 2018.

Located in the heart of Dayton, the recently redesigned and renovated Marriott at the University of Dayton celebrates Dayton's rich history of flight with tributes to Orville and Wilbur Wright's first airplane design. The hotel is close to the Carillon Historical Park (0.6 miles), the Dayton Aviation Heritage National Historic Park (2 miles), the Dayton Art Institute (3 miles), and much more.

The Marriott at the University of Dayton *is a smoke free facility*.

Parking is free. Valet parking is not available.

Room amenities include: Free highspeed internet access, in-room safe, coffee maker, mini-refrigerator, Smart TV with flat screen, work space, hair dryer, iron, and ironing board.

The Marriott at the University of Dayton has a business center, a fitness center, an indoor pool, seasonal outdoor pool, and whirlpool. There are two on-site restaurants and there is also an on-site beauty shop.

Pets are not allowed but Service Dogs are welcome for persons with disabilities.

Local Transportation. The hotel does **not** offer local bus shuttle service.

Hotel Reservations:

Make hotel reservations by calling **937-223-1000** Tell them you are with the C-7A Caribou Association.

Cut-off date for reserving rooms at our group rate is 18 July 2018.

Single or double @ \$109.28

Our group rate is good for 3-11 September and includes applicable taxes and a daily, hot breakfast buffet.

Hotel Check-In: The check in time is 3:00 PM or later. Unless the hotel is full the night before, some rooms may be available earlier in the afternoon.

Weather: Early September temperatures range from the mid 60's at night to the low 80's during the day. September rain is usually two to three inches during the month.

Airport Ground Transportation:

The hotel is 16 miles from the Dayton International airport. The hotel does not provide an airport shuttle service. Taxi fare one-way is approximately \$38. Bus and charter van options are approximately \$35.

If you are considering flying into Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International airport, it is 65 miles to the hotel. Charter van to the hotel will cost about \$90 and taxi fare \$150.

Reunion Registration: Register for the reunion by mailing your completed form and check made out to the C-7A Caribou Association to Pat Hanavan, 12402 Winding Branch, San Antonio, TX 78230-2770. Upon arrival, pick up your name tag and registration packet in the War Room.

If you do not pre-register, every effort will be made to accommodate last minute arrivals, but we cannot guarantee the availability of an activity due to varying prior-notice requirements.

Reunion check-in is from 1400-2100 in the War Room. For those who arrive later, find the War Room and someone will take care of you. If you arrive before noon, come on in and help us set up!

Reception: In the War Room, from 1800-2000 – our usual snacks, supplemented with a few *hors d'oeuvres* from hotel catering.

The reception is not the evening meal. Be considerate of others and take only an appropriate serving of items for yourself to make sure that everyone gets their share.

The **War Room** will be set with tables to sit around and catch up with old acquaintances. It will open at 3:00 PM on 5 September and close at midnight, and then be available from 7:00 AM to midnight on Thursday through Saturday, and from 7:00 AM until 10:00 AM on Sunday.

Exception:

During periods when reunion attendees are away, e.g., tours, the War Room will be closed (locked up) unless an Association volunteer agrees to act as War Room monitor. The Caribou Association – not the hotel – will be responsible for War Room security throughout the reunion.

Carillon Historical Park is a 65 acre open-air history museum with nearly 30 historic buildings and thousands of artifacts that tell the story of Dayton from its settlement in the last 1700's through more than two centuries of invention and innovation that made Dayton what it is.

Wright Brothers Aviation Center with a 1905 Wright Flyer III.

Settlement, Transportation, Invention and Industry exhibits.

The 1850's style Carillon Brewing Company.

2nd Street Public Market

The market is located in an old train depot now filled with bright colors and the sweet smell of freshly baked pies and flowers with over 40 local artisans.
